



LET'S GO FISHING

The Admiral 220, which can carry up to 14, is definitely of the fishing-friendly persuasion. Two deluxe fishing chairs made of multidensity foam and covered with GX48 vinyl will help keep anglers comfortable all day with nary a twinge. The fish will be just as comfortable, courtesy an aerated livewell. Among the other cool features you'll find on board are pull-out tackle

If you're the type who enjoys lavishing first-class treatment on your family and friends, then the Admiral 220 Deluxe Fish is your kind of pontoon boat. New in Parti Kraft's luxury line, the 220 — which the company has dubbed the "Adventurous Admiral" — will ensure that there will be no mutinies from passengers and crew — at least not for lack of creature comforts or an all-around good time.

Featuring construction that includes heavy-duty anodized aluminum T-slot rails, trim and full-length pontoon skirting, this 22x8 1/2-foot rig is both durable and attractive. And, thanks to the company's Stratatech™ Chassis, which features 25-inch compartmentalized pontoons with full keels, there should be no spilled drinks to clean up. The ride and handling on the 220 are reported to be butter smooth.

trays and concealed rod storage that keeps sticks out of the way and protected when not in use. All of these amenities are located in what's called the Fishing Convenience Center, which is also outfitted with two drink holders, a 12-volt outlet and mesh storage.

TIME TO RELAX

Even the nonanglers in your crowd can appreciate the spacious bow

chaise lounge, rear-entry boarding access and an acrylic table that features an Alpha Stone insert — an elegant touch to be sure. Storage shouldn't be a worry; in fact, a compartment under the chaise can easily store an extra fishing chair. And your snacks and drinks are always close at hand, thanks to the 25-quart carry-on cooler.

The Parti Kraft's fiberglass helm is fitted with deluxe instrumentation, anti-feedback steering, wood-accent wheel and a cushy captain's chair with swivel, slider, tilt headrest and adjustable arms. The chair is even vented for relief on those particularly sweltering days. There will be no shortage of tunes to cruise by, thanks to the Jensen CD system with MP3 input and four speakers. When evening settles in, standard docking lights will guide you in safely.

Nifty options include a refreshment center, underseat mood lighting, chaise changing room, an air mattress with inflator/deflator, portable head, hydraulic steering and a choice of depthfinders.
